PTO: Residents must split the holidays, either take Thanksgiving or Christmas but not both. *Ethiopia Elective:* OIC rotation – Maximum 3 weeks. If resident elects to spend 3 weeks in Ethiopia then the one week PTO must be taken on another rotation.

PGY2:

1 week off spine; 1 week off onc/sports; 1 week off each Peds

(no PGY 2s on UCLA rotations can be off at the same time or same month and no PTO will be permitted during the months of Jan. and Feb unless approved by PD)

PGY 3:

2 weeks Basic Science; 1 week off joints; 1 week off Kaiser; 1 week off VA (**Residents on Spine, Hand and VA cannot be off at the same time**) or OV

PGY 4:

1 week off hand; 1 week off VA; (**Residents on VA and Hand resident cannot be off at the same time**)

PGY5:

1 week off joints; 1 week off sports; 1 week off oncology; 1 week off Olive View
